24 17, 2002; the defendant having successfully completed probation,

25 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 26 1. The defendant's motion to retroactively withdraw his plea of no contest to
27 felony Count One is hereby granted.
28 2. Count One is dismissed.


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1 3. On Count Two relief set forth in Penal Code section 1203.4 is granted and
2 it is deemed that defendant has withdrawn his no contest plea to the misdemeanor charge
3 of Health & Safety Code section 11377(a) and a not guilty plea is entered in place
4 thereof. The Court hereby dismisses the misdemeanor accusation and, except as provided
5 specifically in Penal Code section 1203.4, the defendant shall be released from all
6 penalties and disabilities resulting from the misdemeanor offense of which he was
7 convicted on October 17, 2002.

8 4. The registration provisions pursuant to Health & Safety Code section 11590
9 et seq. are set aside forthwith and the California Department of Justice is so noticed.
