**ISSUED APRIL 4, 2003**

James Lissner (appellant/protestant) appeals from a decision of the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control which granted the application of Joba, Inc., doing business as The Passport Restaurant (respondent/applicant), for the person-to-person and premises-to-premises transfer of an on-sale general public eating place license.

On December 18, 2002, the Department received a withdrawal of the application to transfer the license, signed by the prospective transferor. The reason given for withdrawal is that the applicant, Joba, Inc., is no longer in business. Since this withdrawal renders the matter moot, the Department has moved to dismiss the appeal.

In light of the withdrawal of the application for transfer, there is no need for the Board to take any action on this appeal.

ORDER

The appeal is dismissed.
